**FAIR TRADING COMMISSION (FAIR COMPETITION  
AUTHORISATION FEES) REGULATIONS, 2009**

The Fair Trading Commission in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 47 of the *Fair Trading Commission Act*, with the approval of the Minister, makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Fair Trading Commission (Fair Competition Authorisation Fees) Regulations, 2009*. Citation.
2. (1) Where an enterprise is desirous of an authorisation under section 29 of the *Fair Competition Act*, it shall Application for authorisation. Cap. 326C.
  - (a) submit an Application for Authorisation Form pursuant to rule 2 of the *Fair Competition (Application for Authorisation) Rules, 2009*; S.I. 2009 No. 114.
  - (b) pay the application for Authorisation fee set out in the *First Schedule*; and First Schedule.
  - (c) pay the authorisation investigation fee set out in the *Second Schedule*. Second Schedule.
- (2) The fees shall be payable for each authorisation application under the *Fair Competition (Application for Authorisation) Rules, 2009*. S.I. 2009 No. 114.
- (3) For the purposes of paragraph (1), enterprises desirous of effecting an authorisation proposal shall agree that
  - (a) one of the parties to the authorisation shall pay the application for authorisation fee and the authorisation investigation fee; or
  - (b) all the parties to the authorisation shall pay a part of the application for authorisation fee and the authorisation investigation fee.
